"In the Good Old Summer Time" is an American Tin Pan Alley song published in 1902 with music by George Evans and lyrics by Ren Shields ([Go to Wikipedia for lyrics](#)). It was one of the big hits of the era, selling popular sheet music and being recorded by various artists of the day, including John Philip Sousa's band in 1903. It has remained a standard often revived in the decades since. The song appeared in many films, including the 1949 Judy Garland film named after it.
